Our Mission is to provide Educational Equity to under-served Children across the nation.

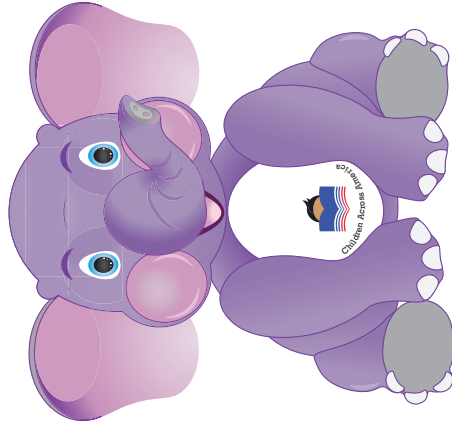
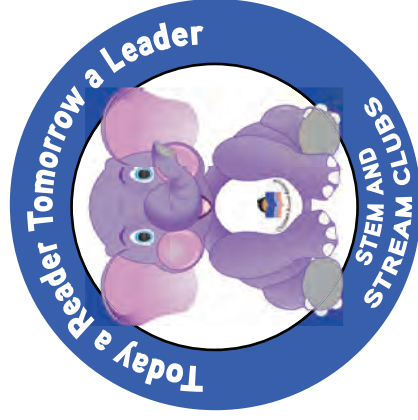
Our Vision is to empower families and children in low-income communities, while providing them equitable access to the tools they need to succeed.

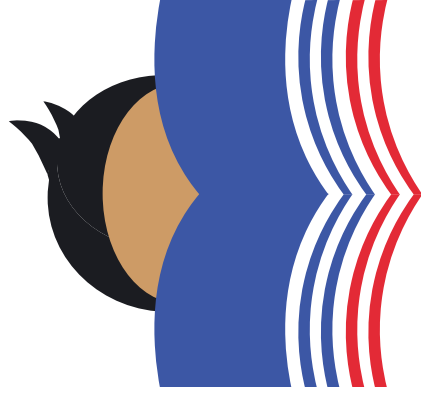
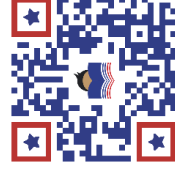

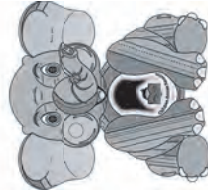

## Summer STREAM Club

All students experience learning loss over summer vacation, but under-served children lose more than two months of reading achievement compared to their middle-class peers.

Children Across America hosts Summer STREAM Club through July and August to provide children with daily educational activities, math tutoring, science experiments, coding, reading, and more. Kids engage with peers their age and return to school with even more knowledge and problem-solving abilities.

Complimentary lunch is provided each day.

## Saturday STREAM Club

Every child benefits from opportunities to develop reading, math and science skills. Children Across America hosts a Saturday STREAM Club during the school year to reinforce those skills outside of the classroom.

Every weekend there are hands-on-learning activities planned to help children problem solve and work as a team. The day starts by reading a book together. We then engage the children with interactive STREAM projects based off of the book.

## Safety Programs

### Children Across America is a Certified CPST Nonprofit.

As an educational nonprofit, we believe learning how to stay safe is just as important as learning how to read.

Children Across America has multiple Child Car Seat Safety Technicians within the organization.

Throughout the year, interactive events are held across New England to show parents how to properly install childrens car seats and answer questions about how to keep their children safer in the car.

## Belle and Friends

"Belle and Friends" are the mascots for our STREAM and safety programs. Together they travel new england uplifting and teaching children.

Belle is a 10 ft tall inflatable purple elephant. When she wears her seat belt she is a "BuckleUpaphent" She always wears her seatbelt in the car and loves reading. Belle is a role model for "Girls in STEM."

Accompanying belle is a multicolored giraffe who wears glasses. She likes to teach children its okay to be different. She represents our Anti-bullying Programs.

Belles oldest friend is Lenny the Learning Koala. He is a fan of wearing his helmet while riding his scooter and wearing his life jacket in the water. Lenny is passionate about science, eating healthy, anti-littering and preserving the environment.
